

FBSM Student Behavior Expectations Form

I, the student, _____, agree to behave according to the Student Behavior Expectations Form of Fellowship Baptist Church of Tallahassee, Florida. I will act in such a way that represents Christ and the church in a positive light.

I agree to the following behavioral criteria:

- Good language, no uses of profanity or the Lord's name in vain
- No purple (guys = blue, girls = red)
 - No PDA, no guys and girls alone, guys out of girls rooms, girls out of guys rooms.
- No illegal drugs, tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, water guns, water balloons, etc.
- Skateboards, rollerblades, heeies, etc. are to be left at home.
- Electronic devices (iPod, mp3, Gameboy, PSP, etc.) are allowed on the bus ride to and from camp, but not during the duration of camp. If an adult sees them out and in use during camp, they will be confiscated until the return home.
- Cell phones are permitted on the bus ride to and from camp. During Camp they are not allowed and will be confiscated if seen. Parents may call one of the chaperones for emergencies. Students may use cell phones only in case of an emergency.

Dress Code:

- Girls:
 - Straps on shirts must be 3 fingers wide, shorts must be finger tip length, no belly showing, no excessively tight fitting clothes, all skirts must pass the flamingo test, no underwear showing.
 - Girls must wear a 1-piece bathing suit or a 2-piece bathing suit with dark shirt.
- Guys:
 - Tank tops and sagging shorts are not allowed.
 - No Speedos or sagging bathing suits.
- Ministry Sites: If a student is participating in a ministry or service project, he/she must have modest shorts, t-shirt, and closed-toe shoes.
- General:
 - No see-through clothing.
 - No clothing with inappropriate designs, logos, or artwork.
 - Evening worship requires pants, capris, or skirt. No shorts.
 - T-shirts with a picture of the Youth Minister will earn you a gold star.

Student will always receive the benefit of the doubt in these areas. However, if a student is found in a room of the opposite gender, he/she will be sent home no questions asked. If two students of opposite gender are found together alone with no good reason, they will be sent home. If a student persistently exemplifies bad character, the parents will first be notified, and if the student continues, he/she will be sent home. Any student sent home will not receive a refund for camp and will be sent home accompanied by a chaperone at the parents' expense for both student and chaperone.

We realize that most students already live by these guidelines and show exemplary character. We do not anticipate these rules being broken, but desire to create the best atmosphere for students to encounter God for a life-changing experience. Thank you for your cooperation.
